Dale Thompson



Born February 28, 1924 in Makoti, North Dakota, one of six children, Dale made his home in Minot until joining the Army in 1944. A combat veteran of WW II and Life Member of the VFW, he was awarded the Bronze Star while serving as a Combat Infantryman with Patton's Third Army, 89th Infantry Division. After the war, he returned to North Dakota and married Louise Walker, his high school sweetheart and love of his life. In 1946 he and Louise moved to San Diego and started their family. Dale retired from Arrowhead Water in 1987 after 36 years of dedicated service. Married for 45 years, Louise passed away in 1991. Always wanting to help, Dale was a longtime volunteer for the American Cancer Society as well as an active participant within the Lutheran community. A member of Shepard of the Valley Lutheran Church in Spring Valley, he spent many hours volunteering there and at First Lutheran Church of San Diego, feeding the homeless, building medical exam rooms, ushering, and ensuring that all is correct, was Dale's method of operation.
