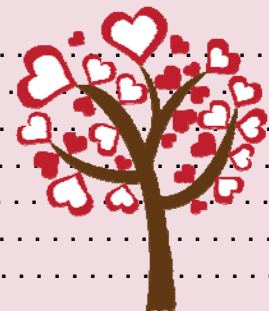

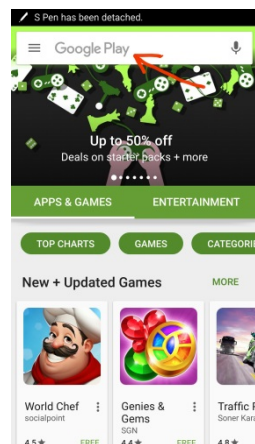
This month we are excited to announce the launch of Stellar Care Snapchat. Using this application, we will be able to send families short clips and pictures of their loved ones. Pictures and videos automatically erase once they are viewed, but will provide wonderful little “snapshots” of your loved one’s day.

How it works: Simply create a Snapchat account, using your loved one’s name as the account name. For example, if your resident’s name was JoeSmith, enter JoeSmith as the account name. If the account name is taken, add a few numbers to the ending, or have some variation of the name.

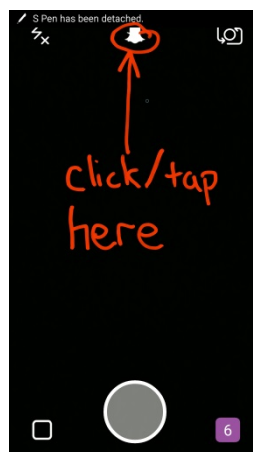
Once the account is created, add Stellar Care as a friend, and we will receive a notification. That’s it! You will be all set, and we will be able to send you updates upon request and during moments we capture with our snapchat.

HOW TO INSTALL THE SNAPCHAT APP

1.) Go to the Google Play store and search for “Snapchat” in the search box. (For iPhones, go to the AppStore and search for Snapchat. If you are using an iPad, Snapchat will not appear as an available app until you turn the setting to iPhones only.) -*pictured right-*



2.) Find Snapchat and click it to open the next window.



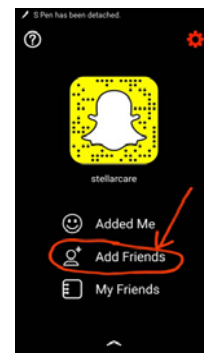
3.) Click on the “Install button” and once it is installed, open it up. Set up an account, using your loved one’s name or an easy to recognize variation of it as an account name.

4.) Once your account is setup, log into snap chat and press the bell shaped icon at the top of the screen. - *pictured left-*

5.) Click the “Add Friends” option. -*pictured right-*

6.) Enter “Stellarcare” in the search box, and then click on the “+” box to add our account as a friend.

It’s as simple as that!
